#### Teamwork on wetland restoration!

We have been collaborating with biologist Tom Willms and his students to assist in beaver relocation for wetland restoration under the Nicola-Valley Institute of Technology (Merritt) and the BC Wildlife Federation. Two beaver siblings were housed recently at our facility until they could be relocated together to a depleted watershed where Tom and his students had built artificial dams (so called "beaver dam analogues", BDA's). Here we are loading them up, reunited, tagged and ready to re-populate a suitable and now protected ecosystem where beavers have been eradicated historically. Stay tuned for more!
