OUR GOAL









Rehabilitation Centre

Our wild animal care facility in Summerland, BC, is government-licensed to care for native small mammals, reptiles, and aquatic birds. We provide nursing and medical care to sick, injured, and displaced wild animals and release healthy animals back into their natural habitats. To protect hospitalized animals from stress while recovering, we do not allow visitors at the centre.

Education

We strive to provide education about how to live with wildlife for the public and our volunteers. We also collect data from our patients whenever possible and are expanding our network of collaborators constantly. Our beaver program includes participation in wetland restoration and live webcams in our beaver enclosures.
