### Long winter, late spring...

In Summerland we have had a long winter of taking care of 2 beaver kits throughout the cold season for the first time! Previously we've had an odd bird come in during the winter, or housed hibernating small mammals. BUT baby beavers? THEY... need 2 years of constant care, indoor/outdoor pool facilities and A LOT of fresh water

and branches daily! That's 730 pool changes during their stay (just for the indoor pool) & several chest freezers full of green young branches as well as leaves. A challenging task when we can't



harvest natural foods during the wintertime. Recently, that also meant frozen hoses, frozen discharge pipes and pools needing heaters. TOGETHER WE DID IT!

Our amazing team filled in wherever needed, built electric beaver doors, remote-controlled water-heaters etc. Now... well, we are even working on a pool filtration system for beavers to use in the upcoming summer season. Go team! "Tiny Tina" & "Baby Nelson" are doing very well, gaining weight constantly and are still visible on our BeaverCam YouTube "livestream".
